#### **ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING STUDENTS**

During the last semester of the Associate Degree Program, senior nursing students must apply to take the NCLEX-RN. If students plan to take NCLEX in states other than Tennessee, they are responsible for contacting the state board and requesting applications. The School of Nursing will facilitate all state applications.

A completed transcript is required by each state following graduation. In order for a transcript to be released, the student's account must be current. Student finance officers will work with individual students as necessary.

Information regarding the dedication ceremony will come from the School of Nursing.

Any incompletes or home study courses should be completed per the university calendar, to avoid any delay in the graduation date and release of the transcripts.

Students planning to pursue B.S. degrees must add the BS Nursing major to their programs. Please go online to <u>southern.edu/records</u> and click on "Change Major/Minor/Adviser."

## **CAPS, GOWNS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Seniors are responsible for ordering their own graduation regalia (cap, gown, tassel and hood) if they plan to march. Instructions for ordering may be found at <a href="www.cbgrad.com">www.cbgrad.com</a>. A minimum of three weeks should be allowed for delivery.

Graduation announcements may also be ordered at <a href="www.cbgrad.com">www.cbgrad.com</a>. The site will take orders for December graduation announcements beginning September 5, 2019 and for May graduation beginning February 10, 2020.

#### **CLASSES AT OTHER COLLEGES**

Students taking classes at other colleges (while attending Southern) must obtain letters from the class teachers stating that the students are making at least "C" grades in their classes. These letters must be received by November 11, 2019 for Dec. graduates, and April 6, 2020, for May graduates.

#### **EXIT INTERVIEWS**

All seniors who have had loans during their stay at Southern are required to complete an exit interview. Seniors may access the interview process online at www.southern.edu/loans.

#### **GRADUATION CONTRACT**

During your junior year a senior Graduation Contract was sent to all juniors and non-graduating seniors to be filled out and then approved by your adviser. By submitting the Graduation Contract to the Records and Advisement office, you have officially applied for graduation.

During the summer months, Sharon Rogers, Assistant Director of Records and Advisement, will review your Graduation Contract and will send you and your adviser confirmation approval of the plan. If you drop or add classes or change your Graduation Contract in any way, a new contract must be submitted and cleared by the Records and Advisement office or graduation privileges may be revoked.

## INCOMPLETES/CORRESPONDENCE/CHRISTIAN SERVICE

December seniors need to make up all incompletes, finish correspondence courses and Christian service by November 11, 2019. May seniors need to make up all incompletes, finish correspondence courses, and Christian service by April 6, 2020. Also at these times, professors at Southern will be asked to submit progress reports to verify that seniors are making acceptable grades in their current classes.

# **MAJOR FIELD ACHIEVEMENT TEST**

All seniors majoring in biology, English, business, history, mathematics, or music are to take the MFAT. The dates will be announced later. Questions about this test may be directed to the chair or dean of each of these five departments or schools.

#### **ETS PROFICIENCY PROFILE**

As a requirement of graduation, all baccalaureate seniors must take the ETS Proficiency Profile in their senior year. Failure to achieve proficiency at level one in each category will necessitate retaking the entire exam at the student's expense.

#### **NATIONAL TESTS**

All students who plan to take national tests during the school year should stop by the Counseling and Testing Services to pick up test applications. Test dates and application deadlines are listed on pages 9-11 of this brochure. Questions may be directed to 423.236.2782.

## PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL APPLICATIONS

Applications to medical, dental, and allied health schools should be made early in the senior year.

Requests for recommendations to professional schools are handled through the office of the Associate Vice President for Academic Administration. Recommendations are sent only at the request of the student.

#### **INCOMING TRANSCRIPTS**

Students who have attended any other colleges must have their official transcripts mailed to the Records and Advisement Office immediately after completing their classes.

#### **OUTGOING TRANSCRIPTS**

Official transcripts from Southern may be requested through the National Student Clearinghouse at <u>southern.edu/records/transcripts</u>. Transcripts are released for those students whose accounts are current or paid in full and who are current in re-payment of student loans.

Graduate transcripts, once requested, are generally mailed two to three weeks after graduation for every student who has finished the course work. Requests that are unable to be fulfilled within 30 days will be canceled, so make sure your request is made no earlier than one to two weeks before graduation.

A student may receive an unofficial transcript for evaluative purposes by applying in person, faxing the form to 423.236.1899, or emailing it to <a href="mailto:transcripts@southern.edu">transcripts@southern.edu</a>. The form is available at the site listed above.
